

WINE RACK

MATERIALS NEEDED:

2 DIAMOND CLASSIC HEEL HORSESHOES - SIZE #00



1. Clean both shoes using a wire brush or hand grinder with a wire brush head. After cleaning, mark the shoe on both sides as shown in photos 1 and 2.



2. Clamp the shoe with 3 marks to the welding table with heel caulks pointing up. Position the 2nd shoe on top of the 1st with heels pointing away as shown in this image (photo 3).



3. Use a square and a magnet to hold the upright shoe in alignment, using the marks as a reference. A small level placed on top of the upright shoe will help to keep it level (photo 4).



4. When the vertical shoe is positioned, tack weld the shoes together at their junction (figure 5). Check to make sure the shoes are square and level and then complete welding the shoes together. Weld both sides.



5. After welding the shoe together, turn them over so that the heels of one shoe are pointing down and the heels of the other shoe are pointing toward you. (photo 6)



6. Position the 2" ring near the top of the shoe that has heels point down. (photo 8) Then weld the ring to the shoe.



7. After the ring is welded, clean all of the weld spatter and polish or paint the horseshoe candle holder as desired. The finished project (photo 8)
